OCTOBER – FIRE SAFETY AWARENESS

There are general fire safety precautions you should follow regardless of where you live. Taking time to review tips about the following fire safety issues can help you create a safer and more secure living environment for you, your friends, and family.

Escape Plans: You should always have an escape plan. You may need to escape within a few minutes of a fire's start, so your safe exit depends on immediate warning from smoke alarms.

Smoke Alarms: Proving smoke alarms in bedrooms may be the single most important step toward preventing fire-related casualties in residential buildings.


<u>Candles and Incense</u>: Most candle fires take place in the bedroom, and may occur when candles are left unattended. In addition, winter holidays and New Year's Eve are peak times for candle fires, so be sure to use caution when celebrating with open flames.

Cooking: Unattended cooking is the leading cause of these fires, most of which start with the ignition of common household items including grease, paper, cabinets and curtains.

MINUTES

Special Meeting of Wednesday, April 20, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.

Chair Ricozzi called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. He reviewed the Safety Moment distributed to members.

On motion made by Mr. Slocum, seconded by Mr. Harvey, and unanimously carried, the committee voted to approve the minutes of its February 15, 2023 regular meeting.

The Committee reviewed the Representative Policy Board (RPB) Bylaws concerning requirements for the Nominating Committee for RPB officers. Chair Ricozzi stated that the position of Chair would be open and discussed additional responsibilities. He stated that he would solicit volunteers at the RPB's upcoming meeting on April 27 and will announce the chair vacancy for interested candidates.

The committee then discussed upcoming RPB member term expirations and RPB committee chair expirations. Chair positions for both the Finance Committee (Mr. Slocum) and the Consumer Affairs Committee (Mr. Mongillo) would expire on June 30.

Chair Ricozzi stated that it would be appropriate to review the new Conflict of Interest language recently added to the Authority's Protective Order for confidential information. He stated that it would be in the RPB's best interest to hold a session on the responsibility of being on a board as it relates to confidentiality. After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee to provide members, at the committee level, with a board responsibility refresher that would include information such as conflict of interest, Freedom of Information Act, and commercial business awareness.

Atty. Donofrio, OCA, reported on his experience with similar presentations at the municipality level, and would be interested in addressing these topics with RPB members.

Chair Ricozzi will discuss this matter with Mr. Borowy, Chairman of the South Central Connecticut Regional Water Authority (RWA), and Mr. Bingaman, the RWA's President & Chief Executive Officer.

The committee reviewed the Authority's FY 2023-2024 upcoming application schedule and held a discussion of possible members for presiding member positions for upcoming public hearings.

Discussion ensued regarding year-over-year projects/programs and the upcoming Lead Service Line Replacement.
